

NETWORK LICENSE HOW TO REPLACE LICENSE FILE WITH NEW ONE

If user has a network license file that has expired, you need to replace the old license file with a new one in the license manager after obtaining an updated license file, please follow below step to update:

1 NEW LICENSE FILE

In server machine, put new license file into C:\Flexlm, and delete the old one.

2 LAUNCH LICENSE MANAGER

- 1) Tick 'Force Server Shutdown'
- 2) Click 'Stop Server'
- 3) Click 'Start Server'
- 4) Click 'ReRead License file'
